These efforts aim to improve efficiency, reduce coding burden, support interoperability, and align with future electronic health record practices. Key developments include the Canadian Classification Browser (CCB), a web-based tool combining ICD-10-CA, CCI, and CCS, and the introduction of provisional use codes from CIHI to address urgent health information needs.

The Getting It Right First Time (GIRFT) program, a national initiative in England's NHS, was established to address this challenge directly. The program's success hinges on the ability to translate vast quantities of administrative data into clinically meaningful metrics that resonate with frontline staff and drive improvements in care quality and efficiency.
